"RECENT TRENDS IN COHORT ANALYSIS"

REPORT OF THE WEBINAR

Cohort analysis is an important application of statistics in modern days. Cohort analysis is a subset of behavioural analytics that takes the data from given platform, web application or online game and rather than looking of all users as one unit, it breaks them in to related groups or cohorts, usually share common characteristics within a defined time span.

In recent trends, the power of cohort analysis lies in the fact that, it enables not only to view which customers leave and when they leave but also to understand why the customers leave. That is how one can identify how well the users are being retained and also determine the primary factors driving the growth, engagement and revenue.

Shri Ashok.S. Tadasad, chairman of our college Governing body inaugurated this national level webinar on Recent trends in cohort analysis. He Spoke on recent trends in business cohort by giving examples. He told; cohort refers to a group of people who have been included in a study by an event that is based on the definition by researcher. The people borned in 2020 at Bengaluru will be called as birth cohort and like this people

who smoke will be termed as smoke cohort. A cohort effect Could be seen in an experiment in which participants use a Computer to perform a cognitive task. The result might show that participant in their 20s did vastly better on the Cognitive test that participants in their 60s.

He told cohort is any group of people with a shared characteristic. In birth cohort what is common to all individuals is their birth year. In cohort analysis, the study participants are followed over time from weeks to years. The cohort analysis can be applied in business, transportation, production and other fields, Now a days it has got lot of applications. With these words he completed his inaugural Speech.

Before inauguration ,Prof.S.N.Bidarakundi welcomed all the delegates and Student participants for this National Level webinar on recent trends in cohort analysis, Prof S.N. Bidarakundi was convenor for this webinar. who organised the webinar neatly He introduced Resource person shri H.N. Patil, planning officer, MSRTC, Pune.

Retired Principal and Professor of Statistics has given keynote address, He told cohort analysis is a tool to measure user engagement overtime. It helps to know whether user engagement is actually getting better over time or is only appearing to improve because of growth.

It proves to be valuable because it helps to separate growth metrics from engagement metrics as growth can easily mask engagement problems. In reality the lack of activity of the old users is being hidden by the impressive growth numbers of new users, whatever the evaluation key metrics we define for the business; cohort analysis lets we view how the metrics develop over the customer life time as well as over the product lifetime. He said acquisition cohorts are great for identifying trends and the point when people are churning, but it is hard to make actionable insights like to understand why they are leaving, which requires the use of another type of cohorts.

Let us consider an example of App. Long term success for APP developers does not mean only getting Someone to download their App, but also getting them to make repeat visits. To get to the must have value Proposition of your App product, you need go beyond vanity metrics like download counts and even daily active users or month active users that only measure growth and retention. we need to dig deeper into App using a method of cohort analysis.

A traditional cohort divides people by the week or month of which they were first acquired, sometimes segment word is often used instead of cohort. He said cohort analysis is descriptive analytics. Customers are divided in to mutually executive cohorts, which are then tracked overt time. Vanity indicators do not offer the same level of perspective as cohort research, Generally there are three major types of cohort, Time cohort, Behaviour cohorts and size cohorts. Time cohorts are those where in Customers who signed for a product or service during a particular time frame, customers who purchased a product or subscribed to service in the past is called behaviour cohorts. Size cohorts refers to the various sizes of customers who purchase company's product or services, cohort analysis allows us to identify relationship between the population and characteristics and that population's behaviour. With these few words he concluded his keynote address which is very

informative and to update us in recent development in cohort analysis.

We had a very informative and knowledgeable resource person of national importance to this webinar. He served as planning officer of MSRTC Pune. His Knowledge and practical utility of Cohort analysis proved during his Speech.

He explained multimodality, the behavioural phenomenon of using multiple modes of transportation .The Study suggested the useful indicator of an individual's willingness to adopt more sustainable transport alternatives .He told about problems incurred in transportation of Maharashtra state as for cohort data is concerned .He adopted the hierarchical age period cohort model to estimate the net effects of age ,period and cohort on multimodality .The analysis showed that travellers tend to be less multimodal as they get older .The age effects may be moderated by work or physical mobility constraints. The total variance in multimodality accounted for by cohort was larger than explained by periods.

This may be partially explained by the joint influence of multiple spatial mobility constraints as well as by the distinctive early Life conditions and formative experience of baby boomers in terms of driving during the economic expansions.

He has taken his own problems and Solutions by considering Pune division Maharashtra state Road Transportation Corporation data. Indetail he has given what are problems in transportation of buses and how they overcame from such situation by applying cohort analysis process. He has taken a particular problems and prepared cohort table and given

improvement points to attract passengers. The example given by him was very informative and understandable by a layman. The delegates are benefitted by resource person.
